He says he has no hesitation about recommending the WESMAR stabilizers and tells this story to illustrate his confidence in the system.

"I purchased the boat in July and took my uncle and 12-year-old son with me on its maiden voyage from Ft. Meyers to Naples (Miami). We traveled through a tropical depression for 6 hours encountering rough seas including 35-knot winds. Things were flying around the boat and my son had not been in anything like it, nor had my uncle. I switched on the stabilizers and

Pusillo who has been around boats since 1968, lives aboard his Grand Banks at the Consolidated Yacht Basin in South Miami where he is the Production Manager. He has been in the marine equipment business himself and at that time held a 100-ton Captain's license. He began building boats as Production Manager at Consolidated 5 years ago. He knows boats and equipment.

Capt. Pusillo's Grand Banks Europa has literally all the comforts of home. From the technical side the

boat has 3 GPS systems, a radar, depth sounder, twin diesels, and most importantly, the WESMAR RS600 stabilizer, and V2-12 25 hp hydraulic bow thruster.

The vessel has liberal use of burnished Burmese teak both inside and out. There are two private staterooms, a salon, cockpit and upper deck.

A spacious deck house opens aft to a shaded cockpit for additional indoor/outdoor living space. The extended roof line over the back and side decks add protected space from tropical sun, well suited for Pusillo who uses the vessel for Sport fishing off the SE Florida Coast and around the Bahamas.
